The Coral Tree Eradication Project - update

This is the last growing season of our three years of funding for Coral tree eradication. Please check out our impressive progress on the following map. In addition to works on the creek, trees have been removed from roadsides and other priority areas, such as tributaries and gullies and some large patches in the headwaters. Recently, a lot of attention has been focused on the Mill Road area.

Please continue to help by:

- checking treated areas for live trees or fragments that may have been missed
- look out for live material in flood debris
- watch for live material dropping on the road from the small number of remaining roadside trees

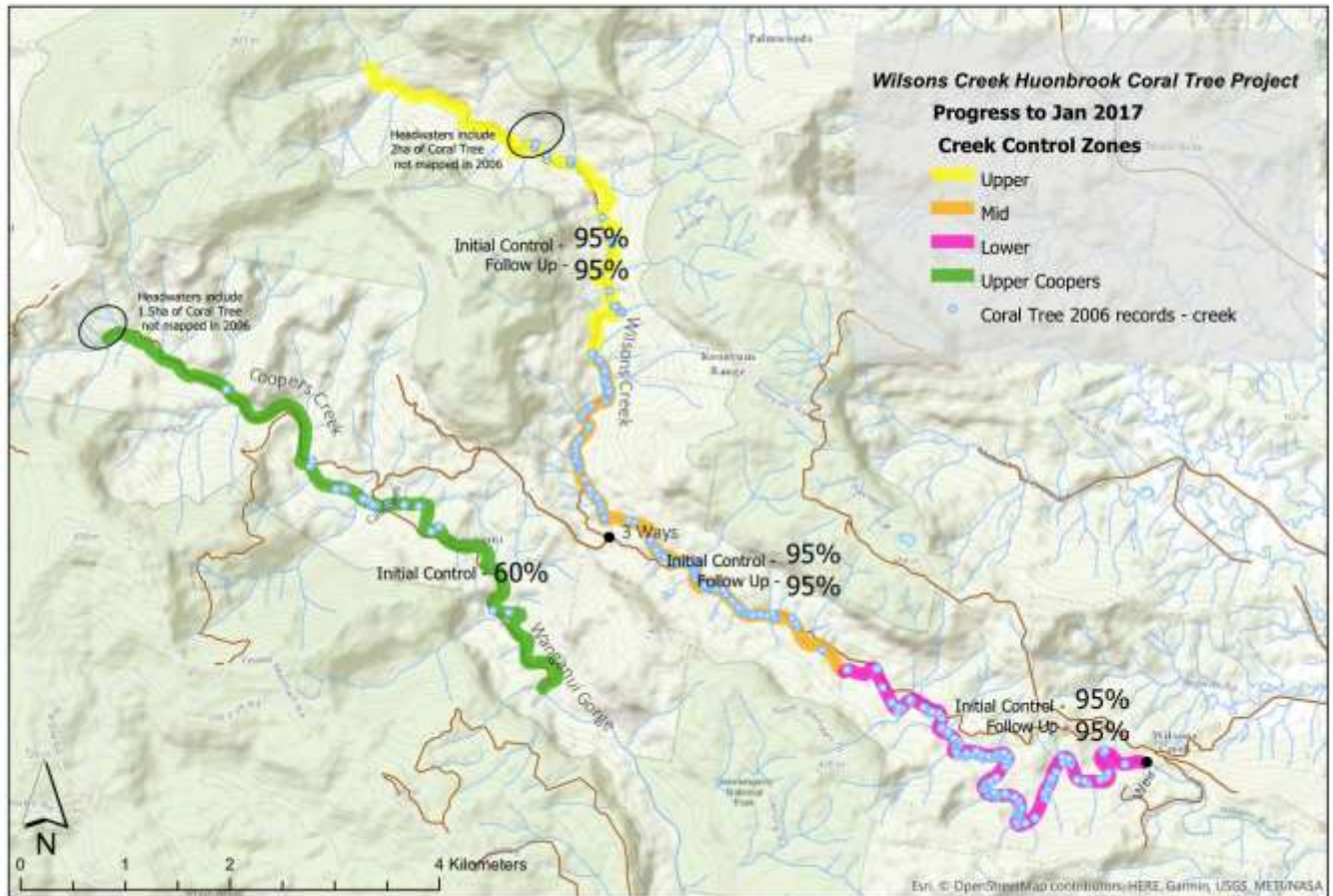
